- Victory Capital Management Inc. claims compliance with the Global Investment Performance Standards (GIPS®) and has prepared and presented this report in compliance with the GIPS standards. Victory Capital Management has been independently verified for the period from January 1, 2001 through December 31, 2020. A firm that claims compliance with the GIPS standards must establish policies and procedures for complying with all the applicable requirements of the GIPS standards. Verification provides assurance on whether the firm's policies and procedures related to composite and pooled fund maintenance, as well as the calculation, presentation, and distribution of performance, have been designed in compliance with the GIPS standards and have been implemented on a firm-wide basis. The Sophus Emerging Markets Composite has had a performance examination for the periods March 31, 2013 through December 31, 2020. - Victory Capital Management Inc. (Victory Capital) is a diversified global investment advisor registered under the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 and comprised of multiple investment franchises: INCORE Capital Management, Integrity Asset Management, Munder Capital Management, NewBridge Asset Management, RS Investments, Sophus Capital, Sycamore Capital, Trivalent Investments, USAA Investments, a Victory Capital Investment Franchise; the VictoryShares & Solutions Platform, THB Asset Management and New Energy Capital Partners. Munder Capital Management and Integrity Asset Management became part of the Victory Capital GIPS firm effective November 1, 2014; RS Investments and Sophus Capital effective January 1, 2017; USAA Investments effective July 1, 2019; THB Asset Management, effective March 1, 2021 and New Energy Capital Partners effective November 1, 2021.
- The Sophus Emerging Markets Composite includes all discretionary accounts invested in the Emerging Markets Strategy. The Strategy employs an integrated investment approach whereby powerful proprietary quantitative screens are melded with deep fundamental analysis to capture the growth of emerging markets companies across the market cap spectrum. The composite creation date is May 2013 and the composite inception date is April 2013.
- The benchmark of the composite is the MSCI Emerging Markets Index (Net). The MSCI Emerging Markets Index (Net) is a free float-adjusted market capitalization index that is designed to measure the equity performance of emerging markets. The benchmark returns are provided to represent the investment environment existing during the time periods shown and are not covered by the report of independent verifiers. For comparison purposes, the index is fully invested, which includes the reinvestment of income. The returns have been taken from a published source and do not include any transaction fees, management fees, or other costs.
- The internal dispersion of annual returns is measured by the standard deviation of asset-weighted gross returns of accounts included in the composite for the full year. If less than six portfolios are included in the composite for the full year, no dispersion measure is presented, as it is not considered meaningful (N/M). The three-year annualized ex-post standard deviation measures the variability of the composite's gross returns and the benchmark returns over the preceding 36-month period. It is not required to be presented for annual periods prior to 2011 or when a full three years of composite performance is not yet available.
- Composite and benchmark returns are presented net of non-reclaimable withholding taxes. Gross-of-fees returns are presented before management and custodial fees but after all trading expenses. Net-of-fees returns are calculated by deducting 1/12 of the highest tier of the standard fee schedule in effect for the period noted (the model fee). Net returns prior to 1/1/2017 were calculated using actual fees. The composite model fee for each period is either the highest tier of the current fee schedule or a higher value, whichever is required to ensure the model composite net-of-fee return is lower than or equal to the composite net-of-fee return calculated using actual fees. Actual fees may vary depending on, among other things, the applicable fee schedule and portfolio size. The composite includes a limited distribution pooled fund (Victory Sophus Emerging Markets Collective Fund). The highest fee schedule and total expense ratio for this fund is 0.80%.
